CENTER FOR DOMESTIC PEACE (C4DP) is a 38-year old, non-profit community organization working at the county, state and national level to end violence against women who are battered or at risk of abuse. Through programs - including community advocacy and support for victims of domestic violence, children and youth services, 24-hour English and Spanish hotlines, emergency shelter, transitional housing, support and education groups, community prevention and education projects, and a program for abusers to stop their violence - women, children and men gain access to knowledge and resources to achieve violence-free lives.

PRIMARY JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

C4DP is building a team of mental health practitioners, monolingual English and bilingual Spanish/English to provide group therapy for children and youth who have witnessed domestic violence, and their victim-parent as part of IN THIS TOGETHER, the agency's new family and group therapy program. The mental health team will conduct weekly family and group therapy sessions in English and Spanish to address the mental health needs of survivor parents and their children, with a focus on healing and trauma recovery. These positions will be supervised by the Children and Youth Division Manager.

1. Provide family and group therapy for child and youth witnesses of domestic violence, age 0-18, and for their victim parents, on-site or in the community, who are a culturally and economically diverse.
2. Perform accurate and timely record-keeping and documentation.
3. Participate in group supervision and clinical trainings as requested.
4. Maintain confidentiality and exercise professional judgment at all times in keeping with the responsibility carried personally and by the agency for the care and welfare of youth and families.
5. Maintain and exercise cultural awareness and sensitivity to diversity.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Bilingual candidates: The successful bilingual candidate must demonstrate proficiency in both English and Spanish.
2. Licensed MFT/LCSW/clinical psychologist/or professional clinical counselor currently registered with the California Board of Behavior Sciences.
3. Master's degree from an accredited institution in social work, psychiatric nursing, psychology, counseling or a closely related field, OR possession of a Doctoral degree in clinical psychology or a closely related field.
4. Two years of clinical mental health experience under qualified supervision in a mental health setting.

5. Two years of experience providing trauma informed therapy for children and youth 0-18 as well as their parents who have complex problems as the result of witnessing and experiencing domestic violence, dating violence or sexual assault.
6. Excellent written and oral communication skills.
7. Familiar with mental health resources in Marin County.
8. Excellent computer and documentation skills. Excellent work habits, adherence to program protocols and maintenance of professional boundaries. In-depth knowledge of, and alignment with, the battered women's justice movement perspective on batterers, abused and at-risk women, youth, and children, and progressive movements to end violence against women. Demonstrated cultural awareness skills with the ability to build a common agenda.
9. Facilitating group sessions includes working until 7 PM once or twice a week.
10. Criminal justice clearance and fingerprinting as required by the organization.
11. Valid California driver's license, auto insurance, and vehicle required.
