- 3. Receive specialized training for your designated employees on how to help survivors assess for the effects of domestic violence on their own as well as their children's health, and provide immediate guidance.
- 4. Track your agency's progress over time using baseline data.
- 5. Become a specialized domestic violence liaison to the Marin Coordinated Community Response to Domestic Violence Network
