TOP REAL ESTATE AGENT IN MARIN PRIORITIZES PEACE IN THE HOME, DONATING TO CENTER FOR DOMESTIC PEACE

WHAT: Top real estate agent Tracy McLaughlin partners with Center for Domestic Peace (C4DP) and gives a percentage of every home sale to help keep families safe in Marin. By June 30th, she has already donated \$7,000 to C4DP in just the first few months of the partnership.

WHY: Once Tracy heard that the number one violent crime in Marin was domestic violence, she decided to focus her philanthropy on doing something about it. Center for Domestic Peace's housing programs include an emergency shelter for individuals escaping lethal domestic violence and offers 21 units of transitional housing for survivors and their children.

"Prioritizing an organization like Center for Domestic Peace made perfect sense to me. Since so much of domestic violence happens at home and behind closed doors, when I learned about this truly lifesaving organization helping so many mothers and children, I knew this is where I had to put my philanthropy."
